To be assured of room accomodations and banquet reservations, registration requests should be mailed immediately to Professor James E. Smith, The Cincinnati Bible Seminary, 2700 Glenway Avenue, Cincinnati, Ohio 45204. A registration fee of \$1.50 wil be charged at the time of registration.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Dormitory accommodations are available at the Seminary for \$2.50 per night. Each room contains three bunk-type beds. Linen service is provided. A Holiday Inn located on Eighth Street is only a ten-minute drive from the campus. The Netherland Hilton and Sheraton-Gibson Hotels, located in the heart of the downtown area, are only a twenty-minute drive from the Seminary. Meals will be served cafeteria style in the Seminary lunchroom. The annual banquet will als be held in the Seminary lunchroom on Monday evening at 6:30 p.m. Tickets for the banquet will be available at the registration des kto those who have made reservations to attend. TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

The Cincinnati Bible Seminary is located at 2700 Glenway Avenue in the Price Hill (western) section of Cincinnati. Cincinnati bus route "D" passes the Seminary campus. Buses run approximately every thirty minutes. The bus trip is about twenty minutes from Government Square in downtown Cincinnati.

If traveling by automobile, one should take Eighth or Ninth Streets from the downtown area. Eighth Street becomes Glenway Avenue as it enters Price Hill. Automobile Entrance to the campus is from Lehman Road, which is one block north of Glenway Avenue.

Air: The Seminary will have personnel posted at the main entrance of Greater Cincinnati Airport from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Monday, December 29. Transportation to the Seminary campus will be provided each half hour. At other times limousine service to the downtown area is available.

Rail: The rail terminal is located not far from the Seminary campus. Take a taxi directly to the school.

Car: Traveling north of I-75, take 50 West exit; proceed a short distance to Lynn Street exit; right on Lynn Street a short distance to Eighth Street; left on Eighth Street, which becomes Glenway Avenue. Traveling I-75 south, take 50 West exit which intersects with Eighth Street; turn right (west) and proced to Eighth Street, which becomes Glenway Avenue. Traveling east on I-74, take Rybolt exit, proceeding east on Harrison Avenue to the first traffic light, right on Race Road, which becomes Glenway Avenue. Travel seven miles to the entersection of Glenway and Grand, turn left (north) one block to Lehman Road and right (east) on Lehman Road to the Seminary campus.
